

INTERNATIONAL RULES

TEACHER'S ROLE AND RESPONSABILITIES

All teachers are responsible for their students.

As a responsible teacher, the success of the project depends on you forming a good working relationship with your partner schools and local staff.

Teachers abroad are responsible for

- Student welfare
- Organization and participation in didactic and leisure activities (excursions)

Some good policies for you to follow are:

- Always be on time. If you are punctual then your students will be too.
- Keep a positive attitude even if things go wrong.
- Have the emergency telephone numbers during the excursions, students' mobile numbers, host family telephone numbers, home family telephone numbers.

Remember that you are a role model so please no alcohol in front of the students.

DUTIES FOR STUDENTS INVOLVED IN THE PROJECT

Students must abide the following rules .

They are forbidden to

- Smoke (inside forward)
- Drink alcohol
- Have, purchase or use drugs
- Carry or purchase weapons
- Hitch -hike
- Litter
- Shoplift

They must also be careful

- not to lose their identity card and use a photocopy of it
- not to lose their luggage, money, credit cards
- not to speak to unknown people
- not to leave the group unless they have asked for permission

They must

- obey the family's rules about coming late when they receive hospitality
- take care of their guests when they give hospitality

Students are required

- to attend all activities and be on time
- to have the emergency telephone numbers during the excursions
- to contact his/her headmaster or the responsible teacher if they have a problem

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
